Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizes of hook type fork carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted tines can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
